At Meet the Teacher, please bring the supplies to school in two separate gallon Ziploc bags per the directions below:

- **First Ziploc bag:** label clearly with your child’s name on the outside of the bag, place: 3 pencils, 1 red pen, 1 large eraser, colored pencils, 1 highlighter, and 1 black dry eraser marker. This bag will be placed in your child’s desk.
- **Second Ziploc bag:** label clearly with your child’s name on the outside of the bag, place all remaining supplies to be stored at school.

Place the plastic dividers in the rings of the binder and bring to school.

The composition books, loose leaf paper, and folders should be placed in a separate place in the backpack.

Label the following items with child’s name:

- ❖ 1 backpack with side pocket for water bottle
- ❖ 1 water bottle with secured, attached closure
- ❖ 1 lunch kit
